



Resident Services

The Resident Services department is the epicenter of information which links affordable housing participants to educational, training and employment opportunities and resources. The resources are designed to help stabilize the family, remove barriers and lead to economic freedom. Through partnerships and collaborations, the Housing Authority is able to link residents to resources such as homeownership opportunities, job readiness, education assistance and healthy living programs.

Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Programs

The Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Programs are designed to help families become self-supporting. Participation in the FSS programs is voluntary. Typically, the duration of the program is five years. The FSS Program provides support and assistance to the entire family by establishing short and long-term goals that will ultimately lead to economic independence.
